We have received a \$50.00 donation from one of our members through clothes sold at the New2You consignment shop.

We received some feedback on the Rummage Sale and the plan to have some of next year's sale items go to New2You. For purposes of clarification, we will hold a Rummage Sale in 2011. Once that sale is concluded, items can be selected from the remaining clothes for placement in New2You. It is understood that this was a decision made by the group during the May meeting. We will continue to take clothes to the local charities, as a donation to them. New2You also takes clothes that do not sell to the same charities.

**New Business:**

1. Table cloths: Pat Weichmann and Alice Shank have been looking at some places and some cloths. They expect to bring samples to the next meeting. We are thinking of cloths in the \$15-\$30 price range. Easy care and stain resistance are features that may add to the cost, i.e., the \$30 or more end of the price range. In Browntown, there is a church that uses plastic cloths, but they do look like lace. We are interested in seeing a sample of those.
2. We will have phone calls to members who are not present at a meeting, yet this is not to pressure anyone into explaining an absence or an effort to induce guilt. It is our intent to make our interest in knowing and working with each other evident by saying hello and that the person was missed. Sandra Varney and Mary Ellen George want to do this.
3. Pat Weichmann did represent us at the work group building a home for Bunky Woods.
4. We agreed to be the hostesses for coffee hour at the last Sunday of June, July, and August. We decided that each of us would bring one dish, which would add up to an appropriate coffee hour for the congregation. Pat Weichmann will head up the June coffee hour; Nina Beran will take the July one; and Peg Goodyear/Linda Allen will chair August.
